



## Master Plan Community Conversation

The poster shown here is a *graphic record* of the community conversation held October 17, 2012 in Town Hall to launch the Arlington Master Plan. About 150 people participated in the community conversation about:

- what people in Arlington value
- what they find special and worth keeping
- what's missing; what people want more of
- what's possible for the future
- what's worth cultivating

Highlights of the conversation were written at each table, and compiled as the foundation of the goals and policies of the long-range master plan and can be viewed online. A master plan is a Town's policy statement on the physical development of the Town for land use, economic development, housing, transportation, natural/cultural/historic resources, public facilities, and open space/recreation.
