

Arlington Center Pedestrian, Cyclist and Bus Ridership Counts

Below is a distillation of the data for the Arlington Center pedestrian, cyclist and bus ridership counts along Massachusetts Avenue. The counts were conducted by volunteers from Arlington's Transportation Advisory and Bicycle Advisory Committees during March and April of 2003. For more detailed information see attached Counting Area Map and Data Sheet.

Crosswalk Use

Academy St/Central St - Average of 25 crossings/hour at weekday rush times

Town Hall - Average of 5 crossings/hour at weekday rush times

Library Way/Water St - Average of 28 crossings/hour at weekday rush times,
and 95 crossings/hour at Saturday peak time

Jaywalking

Jason Street to Academy Street - Average of 4/hour at weekday rush times

Central Street to Court Street - Average of 4/hour at weekday rush times

Court Street to Water Street - Average of 16/hour at weekday rush times

Library Way to Pleasant Street - Average of 13/hour at weekday rush times,
and 30/hour at Saturday peak time

Cyclists

Average of 27 cyclists/hour (total, both directions) at weekday rush times,
and 29 cyclists/hour (total, both directions) at Saturday peak time

(Note: all but 1 cyclist rode on street with traffic)

Bus Ridership

Academy Street (inbound) - 21 riders/hour at weekday morning rush

Central Street (outbound) - 27 riders/hour at weekday evening rush

Library Way (inbound) - 24 riders/hour at weekday morning rush,
and 30 riders/hour at Saturday peak time

Mystic Street (outbound) - 33 riders/hour at weekday evening rush,
and 13 riders/hour at Saturday peak time
